### Terms and Conditions

Payment in advance is required before parcels are shipped. The most convenient and reliable payment options are telegraphic transfer, credit card or PayPal. We prefer telegraphic transfer/direct deposit and bank details will be provided with your invoice. Australian customers are required to pay 10% GST which will be added to the listed prices - a tax invoice will be provided for GST compliance purposes. For overseas shipments, all export paperwork is supplied for smooth clearance - we normally ship Qantas Air or Fedex. Minimum order requirements exist – samples may be supplied in smaller quantities where possible (please contact us to discuss this as different products require a different size sample for best result). Other terms may be negotiated for large contracts. Full supply contracts can be negotiated.

### Return policy

## **PRODUCT: Bulk Lot. BEST BUYING**

This product is our bulk lot mine run parcel containing all the larger production as it occurs straight from our mines, it includes "Large" + "Medium" + "Small" in fixed quantities and ratios. This product is priced at a great discount rate and gives a good range in size for most commercial purposes. Size ranges from 0.2 carats (for the Small grade) up to +10 carats (for the Large grade) – size distribution is fixed to an average of our mine production as below:

Large – 0.90 kilograms or 18% (more info on page 5)  
Medium – 1.10 kilograms or 22% (more info on page 6)  
Small – 3.00 kilograms or 60% (more info on page 7)

Total = 5 kilograms minimum order

Price = \$855 per kilogram (in fixed ratio as above)

## **New England Sapphires – high quality at a competitive price.**



This photograph shows a parcel of cut stone from a typical batch of sapphire graded for high quality (good colour and clarity) – good heating/cutting will produce excellent colour and brightness. When buying mine run, lower grades and corundum will also be present.



**PRODUCT: Large Size # +28**

This larger stone ranges from about 2.0 to 15 carats with an average of just under 5 carats – in this grade, under half is under 3 carats with average of 2.8 carats (range of 2 – 3 ct) and the other half is over 3 carats in size with an average of 5.1 carats (range of 3 – 15 ct). The 15ct size will vary, some very good Sapphire larger than this (up to 20ct) can occur.

WE DO NOT REMOVE ANY STONE - YOU BUY WHAT WE FIND.

The colour varies from beautiful blue on slightly greyish-blue cross table to blue on greenish cross table – some silk may be present, some lighter pieces and some parti colour (bicolor). You are buying a natural product straight from the ground and some variation will occur. Much of this product has been routinely heat treated (basic low heat) by past buyers, however returns can be improved by cutting as much as possible fully natural. Cabochon and other uses can also increase returns.

LARGE MINE RUN



The picture on the left shows the typical quality of gem grade sapphire recovered from this size mine run grade.

This product is sold in mine run form and photograph above indicates the kind of quality present – gem grade and lower grade sapphire plus corundum.

**PRODUCT: Medium Size #+22**

Again just as mined: Gem type and all corundum with nothing removed. Colour varies from beautiful blue on slightly grayish-blue cross table to blue on greenish cross table – some sapphire benefits from basic heat treatment, some lighter pieces and some parti colour (bicolor); generally, this grade contains good blue, and less greenish tones. You are buying a natural product straight from the ground and some small variation will occur.



This medium size stone ranges from 0.5 to 2.5 carats (these are sieved so there will be slight size contamination between grades). Size can overlap.



The picture on the left shows the typical quality of gem grade sapphire recovered from this size mine run grade.

This product is sold in mine run form and photograph above indicates the kind of quality present – gem grade and lower grade sapphire plus corundum.



**PRODUCT: Small Size # – 22 / keep cutting for small cost**

Great Value. You are purchasing sapphire of all grades including the best blue gem grade as well as all corundum and a trace of zircon and ironstone. The colour varies from beautiful blue on slightly grayish-blue cross table to blue on greenish cross table – some sapphire benefits from basic heat treatment, some lighter pieces and some parti colour (bicolor). You are buying a natural product straight from the ground and some small variation will occur.

This grade represents our small size stone and ranges from 0.2 to 0.8 carats - it contains all grades including corundum. This product is sieved to size and some size contamination occurs between lots.



The picture on the left shows the typical quality of gem grade sapphire recovered from this size mine run grade.

### **PRODUCT: Fines Size**

This is value buying as you are not paying for our labour in grading the stone. This product is only available in the Mine Run format so will include gem grade sapphire, cab grade sapphire, all corundum and a trace of zircon and ironstone. This product is processed in bulk so small variations will occur. The recovery percentage will vary so therefore this is only suitable for larger orders where slight variations can be averaged. By purchasing this grade, you save money and can grade to your exact requirements.

This grade represents our fines size with small size stone ranging from 0.1 to 0.2 carats and contains all grades including corundum.





### **PRODUCT: Super Fines Size**

This product is only available in the Mine Run format so will include gem grade sapphire, cab grade sapphire, all corundum and a trace of zircon and ironstone. By purchasing this grade, you save money and can grade to your exact requirements.

This grade represents our super fines with sizes smaller than 0.1 carats and contains all grades including corundum.
